Keymacro is a software tool that can help you automate several system-wide keyboard actions, such as holding down a key and pressing another one, or pressing keys in a specific sequence. Install it When installing, the initial screen will take you to a graphical interface where you can configure the hotkeys you want to use. To do so, you'll need to first click the Configure button. There, you'll have to define which of the available hotkeys you want to use to automate actions. You'll then go to the hotkeys tab, and here, you can set the hotkey that you want to be activated when clicking the button on the top of the page. For instance, you can select the Shift key to go to the next page, and the Ctrl key to go to the previous one.
